

SIS20115 Certificate II in Sport and Recreation



The Racing Queensland Sport and Recreation program is drawn from a national training package and offers portable qualifications which are recognised throughout Australia. These qualifications provide students with the opportunity to acquire and develop the skills, knowledge, and confidence to work in the areas of sport and outdoor recreation related industries. Leadership, organisational and specialist activity skills will be developed through the units of competency undertaken in the selected program. It allows individuals to develop basic functional knowledge and skills for work in customer contact positions in the sport or community recreation industry. These individuals are competent in a range of administrative activities and functions within a team and under supervision.

They are involved in mainly routine and repetitive tasks using practical skills and basic sport and recreation industry knowledge. They work in locations such as sport and recreation centres or facilities, and leisure and aquatic centres assisting with the conduct of recreation activities, and facility maintenance and operations.

Possible job titles include:

- community activities assistant
- customer service assistant
- leisure assistant
- recreation assistant
- retail assistant
- grounds assistant
- facility assistant.

- Eight (8) core units
- Five (5) elective units
